Day 1 – Friday, November 29

Depart mid-morning from Munich airport by motorcoach to Lake Chiemsee, also known as the Bavarian Sea. We will journey by boat to Fraueninsel Island which will be entirely aglow with Christmas decorations and lights as well as sweet and spicy aromas filling the air. You'll have a chance to shop and explore for unique arts, crafts and products unique to the island and lake. We will continue to our hotel in St. Wolfgang where we will enjoy a memorable welcome reception and dinner with our fellow travelers and tour host, Christina Ernst.

Day 2 – Saturday, November 30

Start the day with ample time to explore the St. Wolfgangsee Christmas Market as well the surrounding markets of St. Gilgen and Strobl via boat. The local Christmas market is walking distance from our hotel and offers culinary delicacies, mulled wine, arts and crafts, wood carvings and more. Mid afternoon we travel to the picturesque Austrian village of Hallstatt for some sightseeing and photo opportunities. We will then continue to one of Austria's best-kept secrets—and one of Christina's favorite Christmas markets in the Austrian Alps. The Mountain Christmas market of Gosau is set at the base of the mountains in magical Old World farmhouses. Enjoy listening to brass bands while you stroll through the farmhouse rooms, each filled with unique locally handmade crafts and culinary delights. Evening return to our hotel in St. Wolfgangsee.

Day 3 – Sunday, December 1

After breakfast we will depart for Mondsee, Austria, where the wedding chapel from the "Sound of Music" movie creates a magnificent backdrop for this lakeside Christmas market. Take your time wandering through the quaint streets and shops. Mid afternoon we will drive through Austria's beautiful and tranquil Alpine countryside and lakeside villages until we reach our next destination, Gmunden on Lake Traunsee. Step back in time as we visit the festively decorated fairytale castle of Schloss Ort. The Christmas market here is unique with many regional handicrafts. Overnight, St. Wolfgangsee

Day 4 – Monday, December 2

A cultural and medieval adventure awaits us today! We will travel to Salzburg, one of the best preserved medieval city centers in Austria. This UNESCO World Heritage Site is steeped deeply in history and culture. Take time to visit the many unique shops and Christmas market, or perhaps just relax and take a horse and carriage ride. This afternoon we will continue to the chapel in Oberndorf where Silent Night was composed and visit the museum in Arnsdorf. If time permits, we will visit the Christmas market at Castle Hellbrunn. Overnight, St. Wolfgangsee

Day 5 – Tuesday, December 3

Travel into Germany and visit the charming mountain town of Berchtesgaden which is tucked away against the sheer walls of the Austrian Alps. Many of the quaint, colorful buildings date back to the 1500s and have beautiful paintings of history and folklore. You will have ample time to shop, eat and sightsee. No visit to the region is complete without a drive into the countryside and view the picture-perfect church in Ramsau. Overnight, St. Wolfgangsee

Day 6 – Wednesday, December 4

After breakfast, depart Austria's Lake District and head back into Germany. Sit back and enjoy the breathtaking views of snow-capped mountains and rolling hills and quaint villages before stopping in Passau. You will have time to stroll through the quaint and cobblestone streets to shop and sightsee. We will then continue north along the Crystal Road through the Bavarian Forest, stopping en route at a crystal shop and factory for some last-minute shopping. Afterwards, we will continue to Regensburg for our overnight stay that includes dinner.

Day 7 – Thursday, December 5

Today is yours to do as you please! Regensburg is one of the best preserved medieval cities in Germany. History and tradition spring to life here, and there is something for everyone—from the delightful to the unusual. Meander through the cobblestone streets or explore the Christmas market at Europe's largest inhabited palace. Take time to enjoy a drink in one of the city's 500 bars, or climb to the top of the steeple at the old cathedral, that took almost six centuries to complete. Overnight, Regensburg

Day 8 – Friday, December 6

Early morning transfer to Munich's airport for your return flight home. It's time to say "Auf Wiedersehen" to the charming Alpine Christmas markets and the friends we will have made. We wish everyone a happy holiday and hope to see you on a future tour!
